

FAQ'S FOR COUNSELORS/CHAPERONES

1. Symposium has a total student capacity of 300 students.
2. Registration is "first come first served".
3. AMHPS will provide lodging and meals, and cover registration costs for all students in attendance. AMHPS will provide transportation for regionally located students and counselors (AL, FAMU, MSM, and MMC). Students and Counselors have to pay a \$30 processing fee at the time of registration. Students and Counselors outside the region must make arrangements for and cover the cost of their own transportation to and from the Symposium.
4. All high school students must be accompanied by a Counselor; we are using a maximum 20:1 student to Counselor ratio.
5. Online Registration for both college and high school students is at the symposium link at http://www.minorityhealth.org/student_registration.php
6. Counselors and other adults (additional counselors, chaperones, faculty) wishing to attend the Symposium will use the General Registration link to register on the [Symposium web page](#). Costs are as follows:
 - \$300.00 registration fee (inclusive of all meals)
 - Lodging (room rate of \$129.00 + 14% = \$147.00/per night); rooms can be reserved at 1-800-325-3535 (use event code: AMHPS). AMHPS will make room reservations for SAC Counselors.
7. After registration, AMHPS will need verification of attendance at the Symposium. AMHPS requests **confirmation(s) by March 15, 2010**, thirty (30) days from the Symposium. This confirmation can come in the form of airline travel confirmation in the name of the Symposium participant or a one (1) night room deposit of \$147.00 made payable to AMHPS. When you arrive at the hotel and register THE SAME number of students who have reservations, the deposit will be refunded within seven (7) business days. Otherwise the deposit for any unoccupied rooms will be non-refundable.
